| Application

Entry Requirement:

The applicant must be non-Chinese citizen in good health, between 18-60 years old.

Application Preparation:

| **Application Procedures**

- 1. All applications should be submitted at www.apply.shu.edu.cn.
- After confirmation, students shall pay the application fee through bank transfer (please write your name and application fee on the cash remittance) or go to the Financial Office of CIE at Shanghai University.
- 3. The school will check the qualifications. The student will get feedback in 15 days after the completion of application at our website.
- Students accepted will receive admission files after 15 workdays, including letter of admission, visa application form (JW202) and so on.
- 5. Applicants shall apply for the visa and make preparations.
- 6. New students shall arrive at school as marked on the admission letter.

| Program Description

Intensive Chinese Program

The Intensive Chinese Program can be divided into six levels, students are divided into classes according to their levels.

Meanwhile, students can obtain more Chinese language and China-related knowledge through lectures for HSK examination, Chinese calligraphy, Chinese songs and overview of China, and selective courses such as Business Chinese.

- Two semesters a year, which begin at the end of February and the beginning of September;
- One level will be accomplished for each semester
- Twenty Chinese language lessons (45 minutes per lesson) will be given for each week.;
- About twenty students from different countries for each class.

Intensive Chinese Program helps you:

- Enhance your listening, speaking, reading, and writing abilities rapidly;
- Take HSK examination with more confidence;
- Make friends with enthusiastic and outstanding Chinese students:
- Go to the living quarters in Shanghai to communicate with local people.





A level (start from scratch)

- . Be familiar with approximately 1250 Chinese characters;
- . Be able to make simple conversations in Chinese on common topics
- . Pass the examination of HSK level-3, be qualified to apply for undergraduate admissions on Chinese Language and Arts.

B level Courses (rudimentary level)

- . Be familiar with approximately 2750 Chinese characters;
- . Be able to make integral conversations in Chinese on common topics;
- . Pass the examination of HSK level-4, be qualified to apply for undergraduate admissions on Science and Engineering.

C level courses (pre-intermediate level)

- .Be familiar with approximately 3850 Chinese characters;
- . Be able to make sophisticated conversations in Chinese on social and economic phenomenon, and read plain Chinese newspapers;
- . Pass the examination of HSK level-4 or level-5, be qualified to apply for undergraduate admissions on Economics and Management.

D level courses (intermediate level)

- . Be familiar with 5000 Chinese characters;
- . Be able to integral conversations in Chinese on social and economic phenomenon, and read Chinese newspapers fluently;
- . Pass the examination of HSK level-5 or level-6. Students with high score are qualified to apply for undergraduate admissions on Liberal Arts.

E level courses

- . Be familiar with 6500 Chinese characters;
- . Be able to read Chinese newspapers proficiently, and make conversations in Chinese on extensive topics;
- . Be competent for general posts in China, understand Chinese news programs and write articles with 600 words or so in Chinese smoothly.



F level courses

- . Be familiar with approximately 8000 Chinese characters;
- . Read Chinese newspapers with no boundaries, be able to make conversations in Chinese on extensive topics, be competent for general posts in China;
- . Understand Chinese news programs without much effort; write articles with above 600 words in Chinese smoothly.
